This text has become a confirmation for me several times in these past weeks, and therefore I have booked a return flight on 2 July. On that day it was possible to make a direct flight back to Ehtiopia. I have stayed in The Netherlands for a longer time than usual because of the Covid situation. I have experienced this longer stay as a time to start processing the loss of Co. It was confusing, but very valuable.

Langano

In the meantime the Langano project has officially become a branch of New Creation. This means that one staff member from the community has been appointed as our staff member. He buys the materials for school, for hygiene, extra food for the school children, and next to that seed – in consultation with the whole community, not only with the 12 families. He is responsible for making the reports frequently. The local administration has provided office space. For the necessary financing we have opened a bank account in the region. The final check remains the responsibility of the head office of New Creation in Debre Zeit of course. We are grateful for the developments in New Creation and the positive atmosphere that they are happening in.



Care for the elderly

Because the chicken barn had been empty for a while, it was decided to transform it



into a shelter for widows and homeless people. Together with volunteers, our children started painting and refurbishing eagerly. At that time there was no sign that a Covid 19 pandemic would break out and that it would also reach Ethiopia. On the day that Covid 19 arrived in Ethiopia, it was feared that it would cause a catastrophe, especially for people that live in the streets. Among the homeless are many elderly who aren't looked after by relatives. They are extra vulnerable for infection. For that reason 280 homeless elderly were placed in quarantine for 2 months when Covid 19 came. The government was looking for options for better care. New Creation could jump in by offering the newly refurbished previous chicken barn as a shelter for 25 homeless elderly. A brainstorm was held, talks with the government, and plans were made. In this it became visible that God had provided before we knew what was coming, and made things right. Everything they did worked out well, and also the cooperation with the local government went smoothly and effectively. What a blessing! The staff and the volunteers were prepared for the arrival of the homeless elderly. Upon arrival the elderly men and 1 woman were received lovingy, they were washed, shaved, dressed, and they were given a haircut. God had provided a hair dresser on the compound. During

this time of crisis, 100 volunteers were trained to help the elderly and to work on the land. And the elderly were encouraged to do some light work on the compound. It was very special to see how everyone was set free in their self-worth and contributed with their gifts and talents.



When the chicken barn was turned into a shelter, we wouldn't have thought that it would be used as an elderly shelter during the Covid 19 pandemic! It was Co's heart's desire to create a shelter for the elderly, from the very start of New Creation! Now we see God's plan and provision in this spontaneous project and the development of the Elderly Projects on our New Creation compound. We also realise that we do not want to send these elderly away after the crisis, so ongoing support is needed to give these elderly a loving and respectful time in the final stage of their life. Can you help? What a miracle of God's gracious love! What an honour to provide a shelter to these valuable people.

This is an 98-year old woman without children, family or other relatives. She was all alone in the world. Now she lives in the New Creation community where she is lovingly cared for. She was disoriented because she'd moved so often. Now she has regained interest in her surroundings and she has a normal day and night rhythm.
